

 - 10 groups + facilities






Healthy Ageing

European Higher Education System

Bologna Declaration 1999 in the Netherlands

- > Bachelor
 - Research University=3 years
- > Master
 - 1 to 2 years; 3 years (medicine)
- > PhD
 - 4 years (3 in the case of combination Msc and PhD)






Translational Research- Bench to Bedside and Back (BBB) A full perspective on medical sciences

> Bench:

- Development-Develop an understanding of underlying basic mechanisms of disease
- Design- E.g. Drug design
- Bedside:
 - Application-clinical applications of research
- > And back!
 - Use results to further development





How to become a researcher

> Speak English

 TOEFL 92/IELTS 6.5 are indicative. GSs may set minimum requirements and demand official tests, but most GSs apply a degree of flexibility and go with supervisor assessment

> Locate a supervisor

- Find an expert in your field.
- Ask about research interests (advice/make note)
- Ask to send English CV and summary of research interests
- Refer to website/Graduate School
- > Obtain Funding...



How to obtain funding

> PhD funding

- PhD employees/AIOs
- Few positions
- Apply to predefined projects in competition with the best candidates from all over the world & in competition with master graduates

> UMCG funded PhD bursary positions

- Bursary PhD candidates define their own PhD project
- GSMS may decide to make full funding available for 3 or 4 year positions
- Note: only available for current research master students of the GSMS

External funding

- Many governments offer scholarships for students to undertake (part of) their PhD (& master) degree abroad. Among these:
 - China: CSC
 - Indonesia: LPDP
 - Mexico: CONACYT
 - Chile: CONICYT/Becas Chile
 - Colombia: Colciencias/Colfuturo
 - Peru: CONCYTEC
 - Brazil: CAPES/CNPq/FAPESP (mostly sandwich PhD)
 - Saudi Arabia
- Scholarship/ Funding from medical pharmaceutical industry


- > Eligible programmes:

 - MSc Clinical & Psychosocial Epidemiology
 - MSc Behavioural & Cognitive Neurosciences molecular and clinical neurosciences-track
 - PhD programmes with a supervisor at the Faculty of Medical Sciences





Abel Tasman Talent Programme An opportunity to excel

- Research Voucher
 - One-Month support for short research stays for prospective master's or PhD students
 - Get to know the Groningen research environment
 - Approximately EUR 800 (master) and EUR 1100 (PhD)
- Sandwich PhD
 - 24 months financing (full scholarship) for PhD students
 - 4-year PhD trajectory: two years in Groningen; two years at the partner institution
 - Joint PhD supervision
 - First PhD from Groningen, possibility of double (joint) degree
