STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIP UG & UNAM

The UG and **Universidad Nacional Autónoma de México (UNAM)** have a strong partnership focused on research and education.

In 2019, the UG opened its first international representative office at UNAM, strengthening this collaboration. One of the key outcomes is our **Double Degree (DD) PhD program**, enrolling about 50 students so far.



UG & MEXICO

In 2009, the UG became the first Dutch university to partner with Mexican Ministry of Education, Science, Humanities, Technology, and Innovation (SECIHTI) (formerly: CONAHCYT) creating funding opportunities for Mexican PhD students. Since then, many have come to Groningen on SECIHTI scholarships.

The UG offers the most generous top-up to external scholarships in the Netherlands. This means that admitted PhD students sponsored by SECIHTI receive a total of approximately €1,875 per month, making it easier to focus on what really matters—your research! (Conditions apply).

ADMISSION AT THE UG

In the Netherlands, only research universities can award PhD degrees. Unlike in Mexico, there are no separately accredited PhD programs. Instead, your admission to a PhD program at the University of Groningen (UG) is based on three main criteria:

- Having a supervisor at the UG who specializes in your research area and agrees to support your application
- Securing (Conditional) admission to a UG PhD Program through one of the Faculty Graduate Schools
- Obtaining funding for the duration of your PhD program (typically 4 years for a full PhD program).
